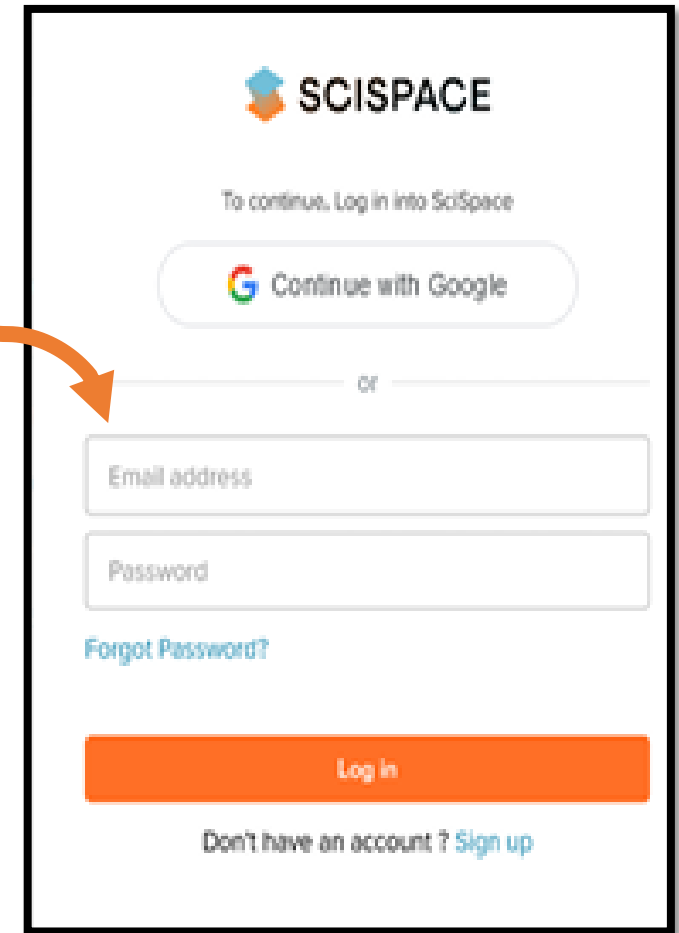
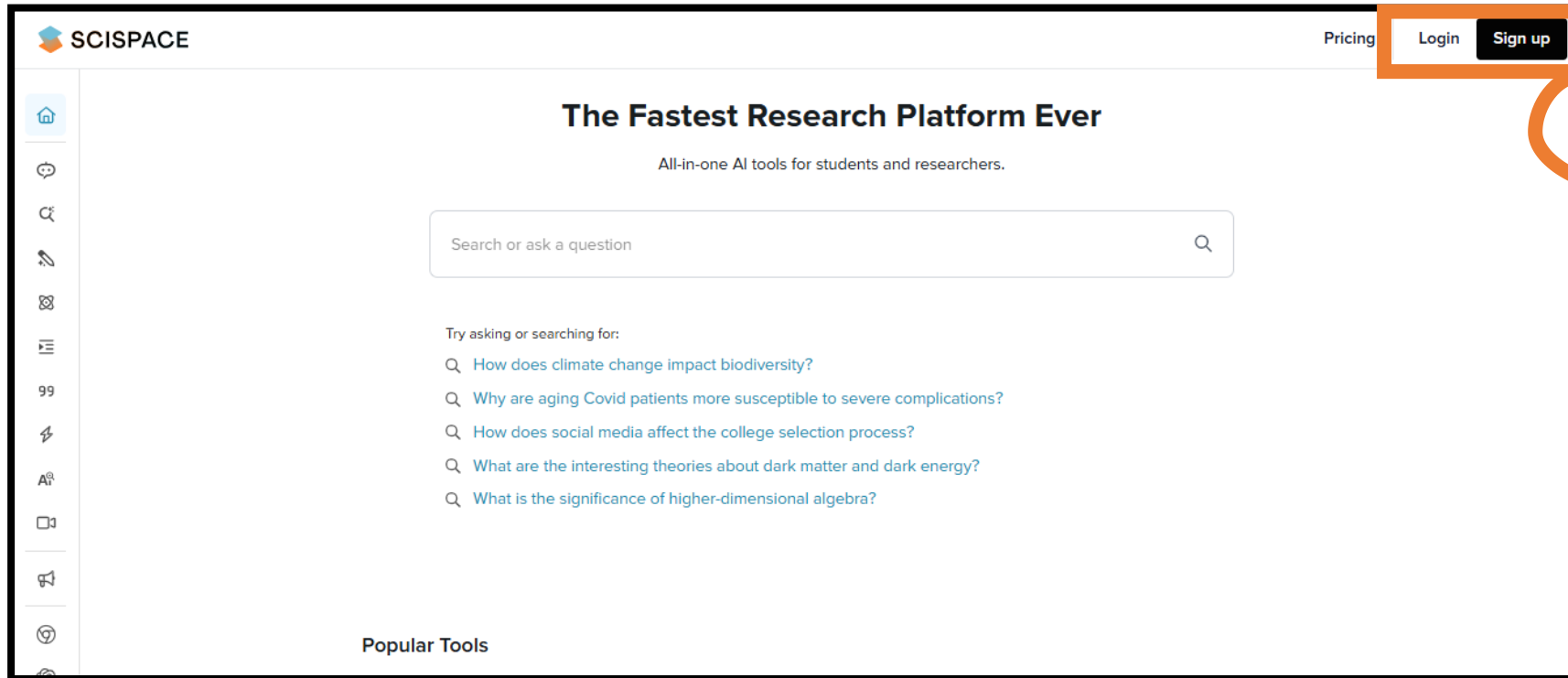

From a gerontological perspective, the relationship between childbirth and Empty Nest Syndrome (ENS) is multifaceted, significantly impacting parents' psychological and physiological well-being in later life. The departure of children can trigger feelings of loneliness, depression, and anxiety, particularly in parents who may have invested heavily in their roles as caregivers. Research indicates that parenting styles—authoritarian, permissive, or authoritative—can influence the strength of the parent-child bond, thereby affecting emotional responses to this transition [2]. 



### How do patients evaluate and make use of online health information?

**Abstract**

Increasing numbers of people are turning to the Internet for health advice despite reports that also rely on other sources. How do they decide whether or not to trust the advice they find online? It could result in poor decisions in general and better care in a targeted way to which those users had not otherwise responded. The computer and Internet information (CI) use survey was designed to explore the factors for information use and how that information could then be used to improve care. The survey was conducted in the North East of England and was repeated through six subsequent surveys. The survey was conducted in a four-stage format of user to research participant (CI) design to explore personal, professional, clinical and regulatory general advice and provide the researcher operating high-quality content because of user design. We identified that most users already responded to online and personal advice before being contacted. The survey reported to us that the 'user' using such content is generally not together with their own CI, although they appear to read and review levels of information use. They subsequently reported preparing advice of use with advice from health, safety and education in order to be fully confident in their final decision. We note that the 'user' followed their decision-making and reported communication with education. Personalized advice from the Internet often decreased user preparation. Despite the use of the Internet the decision was still one of the primary source of information and advice.

**Introduction**

The Internet is an important source for health information and advice. Many of those who have access to the Internet use it for health care purposes, although usage continues to rise. It has been claimed that 80% of adults in the US and 60% of adults in Europe use online health advice (Chen, Brunel, 2005; Taylor & Landon, 2005), although one of the most rigorous population-based surveys conducted in the US, adults use the Internet at 80%, with about a third of those reporting that they had previously visited a health-care decision officer (Rogers, Singer, & Boudard, 2005).
